Can you do it? Try shooting a ball through a hoop blindfolded!

Be a salesperson or a customer. The trick is not to speak! You can buy fruits, vegetables, buns and milk. Or sell them. But you are only allowed to communicate by signs and expressions! It will work - that's for sure!
